## What is it?

- Level 5 qualification specifically relating to digital technology in social care
- Designed for those working directly in care
- Course consists of three main topic areas – use of tech, implementing tech and leading change
- Provides formal accreditation
- 120 hours of study

- Using technology in delivering care
- Understanding data to improve quality
- Data protection, safeguarding and ethical practice
- Digital social care records (DSCR's)
- Plan and assess the right tech for your organisation
- Understand challenges and work with your staff to enable positive change
